

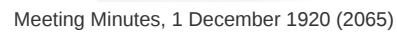


Pauline Edwards birth record (1359)

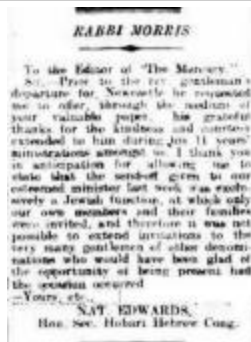

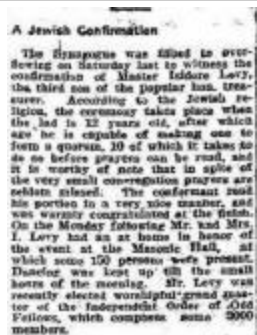

J. C. Davies.—The Jewish Synagogue, Argyle Street, was broken into in the year 1910. The following is the Minister's action while dealing with the matter:—"Police Department 5th January, 1910. Whereas information is now before me that on the night of the 17th December last the Jewish Synagogue, Argyle Street, Hobart Town, was feloniously entered, when a Hebrew Bell of the Possession was wantonly mutilated, the stained landing broken off, and with various other articles of silk stolen therefrom. This is therefore to give notice that I am authorized by his Excellency the Governor to offer the reward of a remuneration to her Majesty's money for a reasonable pardon, in favour of any person or persons who shall, by information or otherwise, lead to the conviction of the party or parties who committed the said felony, and in addition, in the above reward the sum of £20 will be paid by Samuel Moses, Esq., to any person who shall perform the said service. Francis Harrison, Police Magistrate."

JEW'S BURIAL GROUND.

BILLS TO CLEAR AND IMPROVE.
Notification is made in this week's Government Gazette that it is the intention of Messrs. J. Edwards, S. Rogers, and N. Edwards, all of Hobart, to act on behalf of the Jewish community in Tasmania, to apply to Parliament during the coming session for leave to bring in a bill, of which the following are the principal objects, namely:—(1) To enable the promoters to clear and improve the Jewish Burial Ground, situated at Hobart, off Hastings Street, and also to clear and improve the Jewish Burial Ground, situated at Lavenham, Launceston, and to remove the monuments and to erect the remains in that portion of the public cemetery at Cornelian Bay, near Hobart, situated to the burial of Jews, or in such other burial ground as may be chosen by the relatives of the deceased persons; (2) To vest the said premises in the Trustees, Executors, and Agency Company of Tasmania Limited, a trust for the Jewish congregations in Tasmania, and after the removal of the remains and monuments to trust to sell and dispose of the said land for the purpose of providing religious teaching according to the Jewish faith.

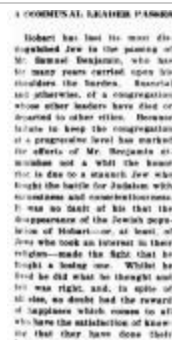

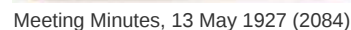
