HEBREW CONGREGATION.—Sunday being the first day of the yearly feast of the Passover, observed by the above community, after the usual prayer for the Queen and royal family, the Rev. H. Hoebel, preaching minister, preached a sermon to a numerous audience at the synagogue, Argyle-street. The rev. gentleman taking for his text "The deliverance of the children of Israel from Egypt," explained that the redemption took place nearly two hundred years before the original time heralded by the Abrahamic to Abraham. The rev. doctor also reminded his congregation that, although they were in freedom, celebrated the Passover, yet the time for the arrival of the Messiah must come when, in their own land, they will be enabled to commemorate it as in olden ages, and reminded by urging his audience to attend regularly at the place of worship, adhere strictly to the Jewish religion, and join with him in praying that their prayers might be acceptable in the sight of their Creator.—*Universal Times.*

On Saturday next, they would have had an opportunity of leaving their cards with the candidates they prefer; but a petition had been presented to His Excellency representing that on that day the Jewish portion of Hobart could not vote. The Governor had consulted him what should be done, and he was happy to inform them that, in deference to the scruples of the Jews the polling day had been altered to Monday. (Great cheering.) Mr. Brewer had told them that an act was much needed for the recovery of small debts. He had prepared such an act, and it had been printed. (Loud applause.) By this act, which would have effect throughout the colony, small debts would be recoverable speedily and cheaply. (Cheers and huzzas.)

The Late Mrs. Cohen. — The decease of the late Mrs. Cohen took place on Saturday night, suddenly. She was shutting up her shop, a well-known confectionery, in Liverpool-street, Hobart Town, when she asked a person passing to take hold of an iron shutter-bar she had in her hand. He did so, when Mrs. Cohen complained of pain in the head, went in, and shortly afterwards expired, death being caused by apoplexy. Deceased's remains were interred on Monday afternoon, at the Jewish Cemetery, the funeral being attended by a large number of persons, chiefly of the Hebrew persuasion.—Advertiser.

A GREAT DISCOVERY.—Our readers will recollect a short time ago that Rabbi Hyam Lewy, arrived here representing and on behalf of the suffering Jews of Palestine. Since his return to Jerusalem he has had three cups, of gold, silver and copper, made for the Temple and forwarded here as presents to mourn. St. Moses, P. Levy, and Julius Harris. The cups are about six inches high, divided into three sections, the exterior of each compartment containing a different view of the interior remains of the city. There is the Tower of David—the cottage of King Solomon—the Eastern Wall of the Temple—the Royal Palace of King David—the Temple of Solomon and the Tomb of Rachel. Round the cup is the following inscription in Hebrew,—
 "Presented as a memorial of respect, from the congregation, to Mr. Hyam Lewy Treasurer of the congregation, of the Holy Town." A similar inscription is also on the base. As a rule of the ancient city is beyond value, and we believe Mr Levy will be successful in procuring its exhibition to the inspection of the curious.

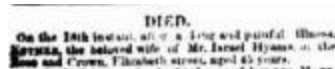
