**The Jews.**—In accordance with a notice given by the Rev. Herman Holzel, the President of the congregation here, that assembled on Thursday last, the 17th instant, at the early hour of half-past six in the morning, at their synagogue in Argyle-street, for the purpose of implored the Almighty favour towards the colony, by invoking upon them the blessing and welfare the earth after the flood experienced had brought which has parched its surface, and rendered the ground almost sterile. At the conclusion of the ritual for the day, Psalms appropriate to the occasion were chanted, including the 65th, 66th, 104th, 107th, 146th, and 147th in Hebrew, versus, according to the ancient Hebrew manner, by the rabbi and congregation. The whole service was conducted by psalm, and prayer, for such purposes, in the Hebrew language. The following is a translation of a portion of them—

"Bless, O Eternal our God, the seasons of this year unto us, and all sorts of its fruits for our benefit; bestow upon us a blessing upon the face of the earth, satisfy us with thy goodness; bless us this year, and other good years. Blessed art Thou, O Eternal, who blesses the years. He graciously to us in the likeness of water, for Thou art the Eternal our God, who sweepeth the wind to blow and the rains to descend—for a blessing, and not for a curse—for life, and not for death—for plenty, and not for famine. Amen."

**T**HE JEWES.—Thursday, the 3rd day of August, having been the Anniversary of the Destruction of Jerusalem—the first time by Nebuchadnezzar, the King of Babylon; and the last by Titus, the Roman Emperor, when the Temple was burnt, and the most horrible carnage with other cruelties perpetrated by the besiegers on the Jews, ending in the subversion of their government, and complete dispersion of that people,—was held as a solemn Fast by them; the Synagogue here being opened on the occasion, divested of its usual ornaments, and a service appropriate to the mournful event performed therein: the Lamentations of Jeromish, composed on the first occasion, having been read, with mournful hymns adapted for the purpose chanted in the Hebrew language, the Presiding Rabbi officiating. The annual commemoration of the melancholy event has been solemnly observed from a very ancient period of the history of this people, on the 9th day of Ab, the tenth month of their civil year.

DISTRESSED JEWS.  
TO THE GOVERNOR-IN-CHIEF AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE HOME AFFAIRS.  
Sir, We have observed during the whole course of our residence here, that the Jews are more complete than any other nation in their being the most despised, persecuted, and persecuted race, that Dr. Sturt, Dr. Leake, and Mr. G. C. Denison, the Rev. Mr. L. C. Denison, and others of the Clergy of this city, as heretics and traitors to the cause of Christ, treated in indignities, the result of about £2000; in consequence of which, we have been compelled to give up our residence here, and have been compelled to go to the West Indies, where we are suffering in Venezuela and other parts of the West Indies, most severely, and still are persecuted by the Americans, and are unable to return to the badlands here.

To the Right Hon. Sir J. Knight, the Lieutenant-Governor, who kindly and liberally received us, and to the Rev. Mr. L. C. Denison and gentlemen who received their opinions to an unmercifully persecuting measure, we present these few words, in behalf of the distressed, as follows:

In name giving them to us, in relation to this religious community, we do not mean to offend, and on the first place, however severe in the wrong done to us, we do not mean to offend, but to allow it to offend in the relief of suffering beings.

The same may stand the Mooney's case, and that the loss of the Professor of the Law, and the Rev. Mr. L. C. Denison, and the Rev. Mr. G. C. Denison, and others, is the second degree of their most evident, greatest misfortune.

A GREAT CURIOSITY.—Our readers will recall a short time ago that Rabbi Hyam Levy arrived here representing and on behalf of the Hebrew Jews of Palestine. Since his return to Jerusalem he has had three cups, made from the foundation stone of Solomon's Temple and forwarded here as presents to Messrs. S. Moses, P. Levy, and Julian Harris. The cups are about six inches high, divided into compartments on the outside, each compartment containing a view of the archæological remains of the city. There is the Tower of David—the cottage of King Solomon—the Western Wall of the Temple—the Royal Palace of King David—the Tomb of Zechariah and the Tomb of Rachel. Round the side is the following inscription in Hebrew.—

"Presented as a memorial of respect, from the officers of the congregation, to Mr. Philip Levy Treasurer of the congregation, Robert Town." A similar inscription is also on the base. As a rule of the ancient city it is beyond value, and we believe Mr. Levy will have great pleasure in submitting it to the inspection of the curious.
