

A Special General meeting of the Hobart Hebrew Congregation held at the Synagogue Chambers July 22nd 1928.

Present:

In the chair Mr. H. Glover President, R. Benjamin. D. Mendes. M. Davies, J. Shapir, H. Epstein, M. Glover, I. Morris. H. Levy, J. Benjamin.

The President declared the meeting opened.

Proposed by Mr. Shapir, Sec. by Mr, Morris that minutes of last General Meeting be adopted. Carried.

Nominations were then called for the office of trustee, rendered vacant by the sad death of Mr. Benson Harris.

Proposed by Mr. Shapir, Sec. by Mr. Morris that Mr M. Davis be declared elected Trustee of the Hobart Hebrew Congregation. Carried.

Proposed by Mr Morris. Sec by Mr Shapir that permission be granted to put on the business paper of this meeting, the election of a Vice President. Carried

Proposed by M. Davies Sec by Mr Shapir Mr R. Benjamin be nominated for position of Vice President, carried on the show of hands Mr R. Benjamin was declared elected.

Proposed by R. Benjamin Seconded by D. Mendes that Mr, J. Morris be elected a member of the committee. Carried.

Proposed by R. Benjamin Sec by M. Davies that Mr J. Morris Hon Secretary of the Congregation. Carried.

Proposed by Mr. Shapir Sec by Mr. Davies that Mr. R. Benjamin be elected trustee for the Philanthropic branch of the Congregation. Carried.

Expressions of sympathy were passed by the congregation in reference to the sad demise of our late Vice President Mr. Benson Harris, Mr. Benson Harris also held the office of President and was always ready at all times to assist in any ceremony and any event connected with the welfare of the congregation. It was resolved to place these expressions on the minutes of this meeting that they may be there for all time. May his soul rest in peace.

Proposed by Mr. Shapir Sec By Mr. M. Davies that a letter of condolence be sent to Mrs. Benson Harris and family. Carried

Proposed by Mr. Morris Sec. by Mr. Mendes that our President be authorized to appoint a

Chasan to officiate for the forthcoming Holy Days and that a sum not exceeding 30 pounds be allowed for this purpose.

There being no further business, the president declared the meeting closed.
