Proposed by Mr J. Levy, seconded by Nat Edwards and carried unanimously 'that the recommendation of the Committee passed at a meeting held on November 21st, 1921, be confirmed and that Mr Leo Goran be appointed teacher and leader to the Hobart Hebrew Cong. For the term of six months from December 19th, 1921 at three pounds salary weekly.'

Proposed by Mr J. Levy, seconded by M. Caro and carried unanimously 'that Mr Nat Edwards be appointed trustee of the P Society in conjunction with Mr J. Glasser once Mr B. Harris resigned.'
