

General Meeting convened by the President

Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> October 1844

The President in the Chair

The plans and specification for finishing the Synagogue having been laid before the meeting submitted by Mr James A Thomson the architect of the Synagogue and recommended by the Building Committee

It was resolved on the motion of Mr Edward Isaacs seconded by Mr Edward Magnus that the recommendation of the Building Committee be confirmed.

The Building Committee having stated that they had met on the 17<sup>th</sup> instant for the purpose of receiving Tenders from Builders and others for completing the Synagogue and that the Tender of Mr Jno McLoughlin was lowest in price and considered by them the most eligible for acceptance

It was resolved on the motion of Mr David Moses seconded by Mr I Friedman that Mr John McLoughlin's tender for finishing the Building for the sum of Three hundred and Eighty five pounds be accepted provided he produce security for the fulfilment of the same.

The following Gentlemen offered voluntarily to lend the Congregation the amount opposite to their respective names for the purpose of finishing the Synagogue
