

## LATE MR. NATHANIEL EDWARDS.

The funeral of the late Mr. Nathaniel Edwards, who died on Wednesday after a very long illness, took place yesterday at the Cornelian Bay Cemetery.

Mr. Edwards was born at Portsmouth, England, and migrated to Australia some 30 years ago. He had resided in Tasmania for the past 25 years, and prior to that he was connected with the National Sporting Club in Sydney, which is now the National Theatre.

Mr. Edwards will be remembered for his interest in boxing, having promoted some of the first contests in this State. He was the hon. secretary of the Hobart Hebrew Congregation.

The remains were interred in the Jewish portion of the Cornelian Bay Cemetery. Among those present were Hon. T. Murdoch, M.L.C., Dr. Crowther, Messrs. A. E. Richardson, E. N. Lakin, J. Stevens, and H. Glover (president of the Hebrew Congregation). Mr. J. Glaser officiated at the graveside.
