British Chief Rabbi Due In Hobart Tomorrow

THE Very Rev. Israel Brodie, leader of the Jewish faith in the British Commonwealth, will begin a two-day visit to Tasmania tomorrow, arriving at Cambridge aerodrome at 10.25 a.m.

Chief Rabbi Brodie, who will be accompanied by his wife, will be welcomed by the Attorney-General (Mr. Fagan), representing the Government, and a State car will be placed at his disposal.

In the evening, Chief Rabbi Brodie and Mrs. Brodie will be the dinner guests of the Hobart Hebrew congregation's president (Mr. H. Jacobs). A service in the Synagogue will commence at 8 p.m.

Later, Mr. Jacobs and members of the Hobart congregation will entertain the visitors to supper at Wrest Point.

The Chief Rabbi will travel to Launceston on Thursday

morning, leaving Hobart at 9 a.m. He will lunch with the president of the Launceston Hebrew community (Mr. S. Crawcour) and Mrs. Crawcour, and will lead a service in the Synagogue at 1.45 p.m.

He will be guest at a civic reception tendered by the Mayor (Mr. Thyne) at 3 p.m. and will leave on return to Melbourne at 4 p.m. from Western Junction airport.
